



TENANT DIRECTIVE

TITLE: Use of Automotive Fuel in Aircraft Engine(s)

I. References:

- A. Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 11.03.02.03-2A(14), Use of Automotive Fuel in Aircraft Engines.
- B. This Directive supersedes MTN Tenant Directive 200.5, dated August 5, 1999.

II. Directive Statement:

- A. This Directive is applicable to all aircraft at Martin State Airport (MTN).
- B. This Directive establishes Maryland Aviation Administration (MAA) policy regarding the fueling of aircraft with automotive fuel (MOGAS).

III. Procedures:

- A. MAA, as the vendor of aviation fuel at Martin State Airport, may not service any aircraft with aviation fuel (AVGAS) that it knows or believes has been fueled previously with automotive fuel (MOGAS).
- B. The owner/operator of an aircraft who can demonstrate that the aircraft is certified or has received a Supplemental Type Certificate (STC) from the Federal Aviation Administration which specifically authorizes use of MOGAS in the aircraft may engage in self-fueling operations at MTN in compliance with the provisions of COMAR 11.03.02.03-2.
